Treasurer's report for the year ended 30/06/10

• Our bank account is healthy, as usual, with a balance of \$4,902.83 on the ledger, and \$4,944.45 in the bank. The reason there is a difference this year is because of cheque number 44, for \$41.62, which was written out at our June committee meeting, but not cashed until early July.

Explanatory Notes regarding the Balance Sheet

• The only asset for the club is the cash held in our bank account.

- There are no liabilities.
- The difference between the closing value of 2009 and the closing value of 2010 is \$487.48.

Explanatory Notes regarding Statement of Income & Expenditure

Income

• No CAMS income this year.

• Motorkhana event, Speed event, and Catering, income are self explanatory. Motorkhana revenue was at a three-year high, whilst motorkhana expenses were significantly down on the last two years. This pleases the treasurer!

 \circ Social income is the profit from movie night takings.

• Subscription income is the revenue from membership subscriptions, up a further \$70 on last year, which itself was \$225 up on the 2008 financial year. This is further good news!

• No Donations this financial year.

Expenditure

• CAMS fees relate to 2010 affiliation.

 Curiously, the cheque we provided for this year's incorporation costs was returned in November – payment was not required this year.

Surplus

 I'm pleased to state that this financial year the club spent \$575.48 *less* than it earned, meaning the clubs cash assets increased slightly over the 12 month period. Whilst this amount is not great in absolute terms, it represents 24% of our net income for the 12 months.

Balancing the Statement of Income and Expenditure, and the Balance Sheet

When comparing the 'profit' of the club reported on the Income and Expenditure Statement with the difference in the opening and closing values, a discrepancy of \$88 is observed. This relates to the \$88 noted on the July reconciliation, which relates to monies deposited into the bank account in the last financial year, but not tabled until the July Committee meeting.

The Wuillemin brothers wheeled out their new Special for testing on the bitumen, it went fast for a couple of runs, but sadly it ended the day early after only two tests.


Some of the competitors were not impressed with having to do а reversing test first. 11 HAC members ran in the event, Michael Exell won outright and 1st Class F.



Bendigo hot-mix bitumen at Bendigo Livestock Exchange, Leans Road, Huntly. Take the Midland Highway until it curves to the right 13 km north of Bendigo city centre, turn left into Leans Road, go 1.5 km, turn left into Wallenjoe Road, go 500 metres and it's on the right – see Melway 509 E2.



Deniliquin grass/dirt DSCC club ground on the Racecourse Road about 5km west of Deniliquin, just south of the racecourse

Lardner Park From Monash Fwy, continue on Princes Fwy for 61.0 km, take the exit toward Drouin-Warragul Rd for 0.4 km, slight left into Drouin -Warragul Rd for 0.4 km, turn right (cross railway line) into Lardners Track for 6.2 km, turn left into Currie Rd for 1.1 km, enter Gate 5 of Lardner Park on the left..
